



TRAVELING TO **PATAGONIA**

For many, travelling down to the Patagonia region of South America can seem daunting. The most interesting and foreign elements of such a remote landscape can also be the most unnerving. Mirr Ranch Group and Patagonia Sur are here for you.

>>>VIA ARGENTINA

For some properties, one can arrive through Buenos Aires, Argentina. There are direct flights from the United States to Buenos Aires. The two main airports are Ministro Pistarini International Airport and Aeroparque Jorge Newberry. From each of these airports, individuals can take a connecting 2.5 hour flight to Esquel via Aerolineas Argentinas. This is a viable option when travelling to Valle California, Rio Palena, Lago Espolon, Los Leones, and El Palenque.

Patagonia Sur has created a guide to make it easy to visit and access their properties in Chilean Patagonia, and recommends a one week stay for interested buyers. They advise that one can either take a connecting flight directly upon arriving in Buenos Aires or stay a night in the city before flying to Esquel. Patagonia Sur will provide transportation from Esquel to Valle California, Rio Palena, and Lago Espolon.

At the latest, one should arrive at the interested property on the third day of travel, as to get the most of their stay. After being at the different properties for at least four days Patagonia Sur will provide transportation back to Esquel.

>>>VIA CHILE

The other viable option is via Santiago. In order to get to the Jeinimeni and Tortel properties, this is your best travel plan. Once in Santiago, one may then take connecting flights to Puerto Montt El Tepual Airport or Palena where they can then access the different properties.
